These are your responsibilities:

Coordination of the "EUNICE4U" project funded by the European University Networks (EUN) at BTU, in particular:

- Coordination and active management of the information flow between the external and internal project partners involved as well as coordination and planning of the work with regard to the individual work packages described in the work programme ("Description of Work") in the fields of teaching, research, innovation and technology transfer, further education and digitisation
- Providing background information to inform strategic decision-making
- Coordination of work package 4 "Research-driven bridges among university, business & society": together with the lead university (University of Catania) coordination of the work in work package 4 as co-lead, progress review against the milestones and deliverables described in the work programme ("Description of Work"), communication and review of the work to be done with and at the partner universities
- Presenting the project and advising academics and administrative staff on networking opportunities within the project
- Maintaining contact with the project partners, representing BTU at alliance meetings, using and maintaining joint work platforms, supporting all BTU staff involved in coordinating their work in the individual work packages
- Project management: budget planning and monitoring, monitoring the progress of work with regard to the milestones described in the work programme ("Description of Work") and the deliverables for all work packages 1 to 5, preparation of technical reports, support of third-party funding management (HVP3) in the preparation of financial reports

Your Skills:

A university degree (accredited Master's degree, university diploma or equivalent) in a subject suitable for the position is required, for example language and cultural area studies, intercultural communication, international relations, economics or similar subjects equally suitable for the position.

You have the following knowledge and/or experience:

- very good knowledge of European funding structures and experience in the field of national and international funding programmes and their management
- very good knowledge of the German and European higher education landscape and European higher education policy, also through your own substantial experience abroad

- Relevant experience in project and process management
- Work experience in the field of internationalisation at a university/ in the academic sector, in public institutions or companies
- Experience of working independently with (international) partner institutions and networks
- Very good knowledge of written and spoken German and English
- Basic knowledge of project budget planning, management and control

You have the necessary powers of persuasion, team spirit and commitment.
